The idea of this presentation is to go through the process of building structure in a search dog.

Structure let us cover reliably and in an organized manner our search sector and have a higher Probability of Detection-POD. Also, along with direction work, help us putting our dog in the scent cone, and further produce a Find. This will have a direct impact on the quality of the search and maximizing the resources used.

This lecture intends to share techniques and resources to have a more structured searching dog. Different currents argue that it may have impact on the independence of the dog and its capacity of staying focused in the search, these thoughts will be also discussed during the presentation with videos and examples.
