The collaboration with the UIAA has been realized. We have a permanent delegate in UIAA Safecom.

There are working groups in the following areas:

- Static ropes, IKAR is a member of this working group.
- Anchor Welding WG (welding anchors). The problem here is corrosion.
- Helmets.
- Canyoning harnesses (Alexis Mallon is the head of this working group).
- Sharp edges, tests: The problem of ropes being cut on sharp edges is addressed.
- Cable Wire 104 rewording. It is about the 104 UIAA label. This must be correctly described.
- 130 LDS Update
- Headlamps. These can cause interference with avalanche transceivers.
- EU standard for avalanche airbags.
- UIAA standard for avalanche transceivers (LVS).



• Rescues at high altitudes (UIAA and ICAR), TERCOM is also a member of this working group.
